Two Religious sisters from Clyde, Mo., have perfected an almost gluten free bread (0.01%) that the church does approve. Experts in the field attest that this is safe for almost all who have this need, although for some even this may be too much. We are in the process of determining how we can best minister Holy Communion to those who have this special need.

In the church's long tradition and teaching, only the priest is allowed to give communion to oneself. Please help us to continue that teaching in practice.

If you are one with this disease, please let us know and we will present you with the options approved by the church.
