Nicknames: Did you have one? Did you like it? Did it stick with you? Some nicknames are pretty obvious in their origins like "Shorty" or "Lefty" or "Irish." Some clearly were terms of endearment given to a baby or a child that stuck like "Baby" or "Junior." Some may be diminutives of longer names like "Little Joe" or "J Lo." Some are nonsense syllables first spoken by a sibling many years ago like "Zu-Zu" or "Momo." After a while, some people seem to grow into their nicknames. They look or act like them. It becomes the only name by which they are known by many people.

When we call God "Father" or "Son" or "Holy Spirit," these aren't three separate nicknames. The reality is that God just by being God is more than can possibly be held in one name. The most we can do is identify the reality of God in three separate and distinct persons. We experience God who created us and our world. We share in the God who lived among us and as one like us. And we hold in our hearts the presence of God who animates us with an inexplicable unconditional love. All of this is our God and more, that more being what we are unable to put into words but know and believe to be real.
